### PROGRAM DETAILS

This is a supportive learning program for immigrant and refugee women who have little or no formal education. The program helps participants learn basic English, reading, writing, and everyday life skills.

Participants learn in a safe and welcoming environment with teachers and mentors who understand their needs.

- Understanding health care and medical services
- Learning about money and financial literacy
- Learning about Indigenous culture and history education

Participants build confidence and independence in everyday life.

- Use public transportation
- Visit community places like libraries and recreation centres
- Attend neighbourhood events
- Book medical appointments
- Use computers and access online information
- Support their children's learning and school activities
